

Dear District 21 Parents,

This summer, School District 21 will provide an Enrichment Program for students who are currently in grades 5, 6, and 7. The Enrichment Program will be held at Holmes Middle School. This brochure provides all the information you will need to enroll. If you would like your child to participate, please fill out the enrollment form on the back of this brochure and return it with your payment to your child's school. Make checks payable to School District 21. Students should contact their orchestra director for information about summer orchestra; summer band information is included in this catalog.

TRANSPORTATION

For students who do not live within walking distance of Holmes, bus transportation costs for the Enrichment Program will be \$45 for the June session and \$30 for the August session. Specific details about the bus schedule will be sent home with confirmation slips late-May.

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

We will offer a three-week program in June and a two-week program in August. Students may attend in June or August or both. Course fees vary depending upon the length of the program.

On the last page of this brochure, you will find an application form. Please fill it out completely and return it to your child's school. Once the application is received, we will schedule your child in the appropriate class(es).

If your family qualified for "free and reduced lunch" or "waiver of fees" during the 2009-10 school year, you may apply for a scholarship for summer school. If granted, the only registration fee due would be a non-refundable course fee charge of \$15 per June and/or August session and bus fees for the Enrichment Courses.

All classes have a class size limit. Therefore a "**first-come, first served**" procedure will be used to fill the classes. The date that the registration form is returned to school will serve as the determination for class placement. It is important that you return it as soon as you have made your selection(s).

In order to guarantee that your child will have a full morning of summer school classes, please consider an alternate class. All classes are self-supporting, and we need approximately 15 students to sign up before a class can be offered. So, if your first choice is canceled because of low enrollment, your alternate will be substituted. Don't be disappointed, **THINK ALTERNATE!**

REFUND POLICY

There will be no refunds unless your class is canceled due to low enrollment.
